Its burner system has performed valiantly for over 40 years, but is heavily cracked and warped. The repairs are complicated by the fact that the manufacturer went out of business 15 years ago.

The new high-efficiency Power Flame burner and modern control system will cost \$33,070. We want to keep you informed, as we are all in this together.
