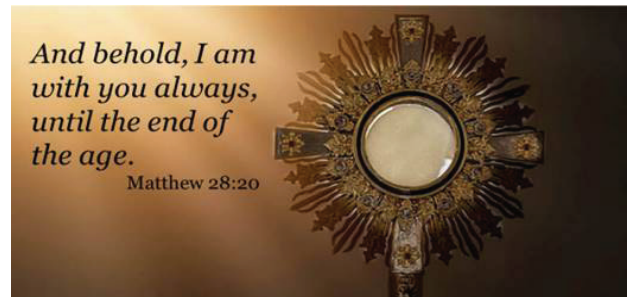
SUMMER GIVING
