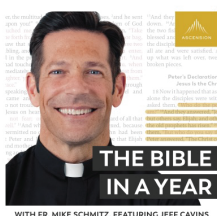

FAITH FORMATION

Classes start October 7, 2026. They will be held each Wednesday through the end of April, 2027. Instruction is from 6pm to 7pm and dinner is served at 7pm. There is no charge for participation or dinner. These classes are for everyone, not just for families or children. The class offerings include First Communion, Confirmation, Apologetics, All Age Faith Formation (a.k.a. family class), and and Momnipotent, an 8-Week Bible Study by Ascension Press.

Momnipotent is an eight-session study designed to inspire and support mothers as they rediscover the beauty, meaning, and purpose of their vocation.
